



Hosted by the Gold Coast Succulent & Bromeliad Society Inc at the Sea World Resort on the Gold Coast



**Venue:** The Sea World Resort is situated at the northern end of The Spit on the Gold Coast in Queensland, about 1 hour south of Brisbane. The conference centre is located near the entrance to the resort. The centre seats over 500 delegates at round tables, with separate spaces for plant sales and society/trade displays and sales. Events during the conference will be held in the centre and in the adjoining resort facilities and the Sea World Piazza adjacent to the resort.



Accommodation: Rooms can be booked at the Sea World Resort for approximately \$190 per room; each room has two double beds. This special room rate is available to delegates and their families for 3 days before and after the conference. Delegates and their families will also be able to buy tickets for unlimited entry to Sea World, Movie World, and the Outback Spectacular at a reduced rate while staying at the resort.

**Location:** The Gold Coast is Australia's premier holiday destination, offering world-class beaches, theme parks, and

other tourist attractions, including whale watching, shopping, restaurants.

It is serviced by two airports—Brisbane International and Domestic (about 1 hour to the north) and Coolangatta Airport (on the southern end of the Gold Coast, about 25 minutes by car from the venue). Coolangatta Airport also has flights to New Zealand. Transfer buses are available from both airports to the resort.

The Gold Coast hinterland is also a tourist destination, offering spectacular scenery, rain forests, and waterfalls within a short drive from the resort.

The tour desk at the resort can book tours of the Gold Coast and the hinterland for delegates and their families

**Make It a Family Holiday:** Each room at the report has two double beds, so bring your family. There will be a reduced rate for unlimited entry to Sea World and 2 other theme parks for the duration of your stay.

**Climate:** The Gold Coast has about 300 days of sunshine each year. In October, temperatures range from  $15^{\circ} - 25^{\circ}$  Celsius, and there is almost always a cooling sea breeze.

**Registration** will be \$350 for full conference registration until 30 June 2019. Registration after that date will be \$375. This includes entry to all presentations, Welcome BBQ and Conference Opening, Banquet, full day tour to gardens, and morning, afternoon teas and lunches on conference days. Extra tickets will be \$80 for the Welcome BBQ, \$95 for the Banquet and \$50 for the full day tour (includes boxed lunch).
