NEW BROMELIAD BOOK LAUNCHED AT BSQ SPRING SHOW

At the BSQ Spring Show, the Second Edition of BSQ's 'Starting with Bromeliads' book was officially launched by Jeremy Colby-Williams from the ABC's Gardening Australia.


Cash and EFTPOS available

Jewels of the Jungle - Bromeliaceae of Ecuador (Part I - Bromelioideae)

by José M. Manzanares (2001).

This is Part I of a trilogy on the study of the Bromeliaceae of Ecuador.

Bromeliodeae is the first volume embracing seven genera of this subfamily found in Ecuador. It includes *Ananus*, *Aechmea*, *Billbergia*, *Bromelia*, *Gregia*, *Neoregelia* and *Ronnbergia*.

Each species is shown in detail with a description of the plant, collections studied, distribution, etymology, keys and detailed photographs.

It is a large hardback limited and numbered edition with 240 pages and 341 illustrations.



On the last weekend in September, the Bromeliad Society of Queensland held its annual Spring Show and Sales event. A number of our members who are also BSQ members ventured south to participate as exhibiters, sellers and helpers.

The Show had 143 entries and were judged by two groups of judges. Plants were awarded an Award of Merit (purple ribbon) by scoring 95 to 100 points. Those scoring 90 to 94 points awarded a blue ribbon and those with 85 to 89 points received a Red Ribbon.
