FCBSI @ BSQ Spring Show ...

On the same weekend as the Hervey Bay Orchid Show, the Bromeliad Society of Queensland held its annual Spring Show and Sales event. A number of our members who are also BSQ members ventured south to participate as exhibiters, sellers and helpers.

The Show had 95 entries and were judged by two groups of judges. Plants were awarded an Award of Merit (purple ribbon) by scoring 95 to 100 points. Those scoring 90 to 94 points awarded a blue ribbon and those with 85 to 89 points received a Red Ribbon.

Nigel Thomson had a successful weekend winning the Champion Bromeliad of the Show with Quesnellia alvimii and wins the Olwyn Ferris Trophy.
