SEPTEMBER MONTHLY MEETING REPORT ...

It is very pleasing to see members getting behind our themed 'Show, Tell and Ask' segment. This month we asked members to bring in any bulbous Tillandsia's they grow. The size varied from a tiny *T. butzii* through to *T. caput-medusae* (giant form) to the hybrids... *T. 'Charles Wiley'* and *T. 'Loose Wheel'*. Some other names I noted on a piece of paper were: *T. bulbosa, T. selereana, T. bulbosa* again in a 'dark and hairy' form, *T. 'Bishop John Fisher'*. Again, I got so caught up in the proceedings that I forgot to take notes.

Thank you to members who brought in plants to share with us and further our knowledge of Bromeliads.

Nigel Thomson was our speaker this month and took us through his experiences, both past and present of importing plants into Australia. He outlined the various issues with quarantine, from preparing and packing the plants in the country of origin, to arrival inspections, permits, and the time lapse to get the plants into importers collection/nursery. It's no wonder plants, when first released by the various growers, command the prices they do.

We closed out the meeting with the raffle being drawn. I look forward to seeing you next meeting.

HERVEY BAY ORCHID SHOW REPORT ...

Once again, the Society attended the HBOS Show to promote our Society, bromeliads, as well as the opportunity to sell some Bromeliads to the community.
