GLOSSARY TERMS ...

INTERGENERIC CROSS - The crossing of two species of two different genera from the same sub family to form a hybrid genus.

An example of an intergeneric hybrid was tabled at the recent BSQ Autumn Show by Stan Walkley.

The specimen is a cross between *Encholirium hooridum and Dyckia delicata*. George Stamanis is the hybridist for this cross.

Both genera are part of the sub-family *Pitcairnioideae*

The BSQ Autumn Show and Sale was held on the third weekend in March with several of our members participating as volunteers, sellers, competitors and buyers.




